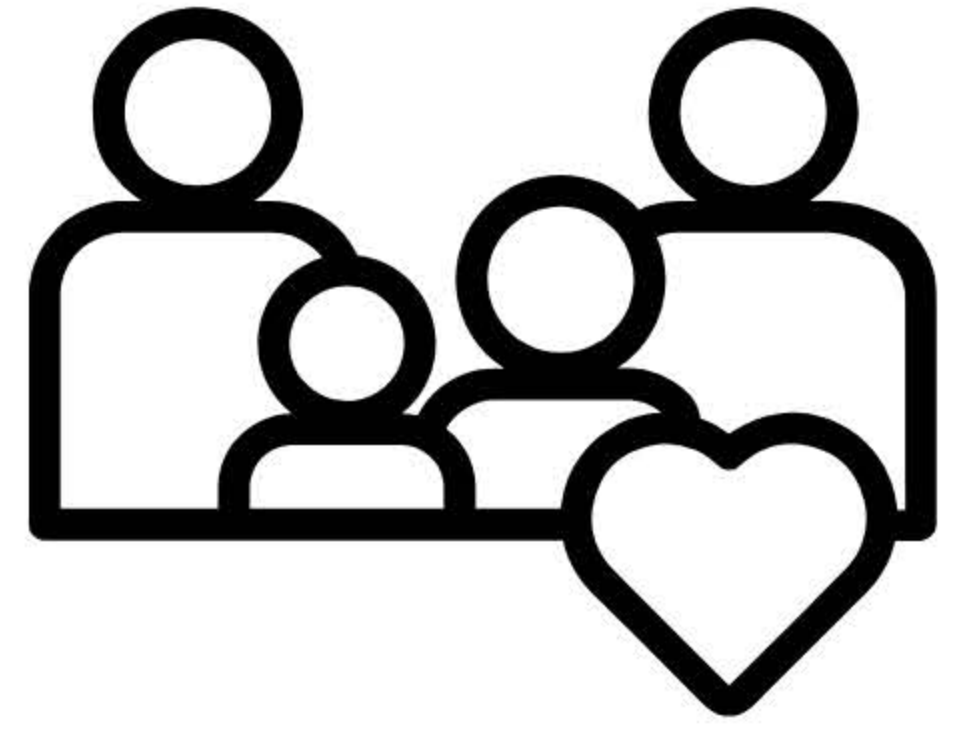


Be Part of Autism Research!

The purpose of the **IRIS Study** is to test an investigational medication, named **ML-004**. This study medicine works on the serotonin system, which is thought to shape social behaviors. We want to see if ML-004 has potential benefits on social communication.

- 12-17 years of age
- Diagnosed with or suspected to have ASD
- Have a caregiver willing to assist in the study
- Complete 10 visits over \approx 6 months at the Center for Autism and the Developing Brain (CADB) in White Plains, NY
- Participants will be compensated for their time and receive travel reimbursements
